






TIME PERIOD FOR THE MOST RECENT 300 SCHOOL SHOOTINGS

## Individualized to LEA Needs


**In the event of a crisis occurring in a LEA,

- Makes contact to the LEA Behavior/Mental Health Leadership Network designee
- Shares evidence-based crisis response practices and community resources with designee
  - Ex: grief resources, restoring calm, responding to anxiety and fears
- Offers additional individualized support upon the LEA's request, such as response planning, counseling services, etc.
