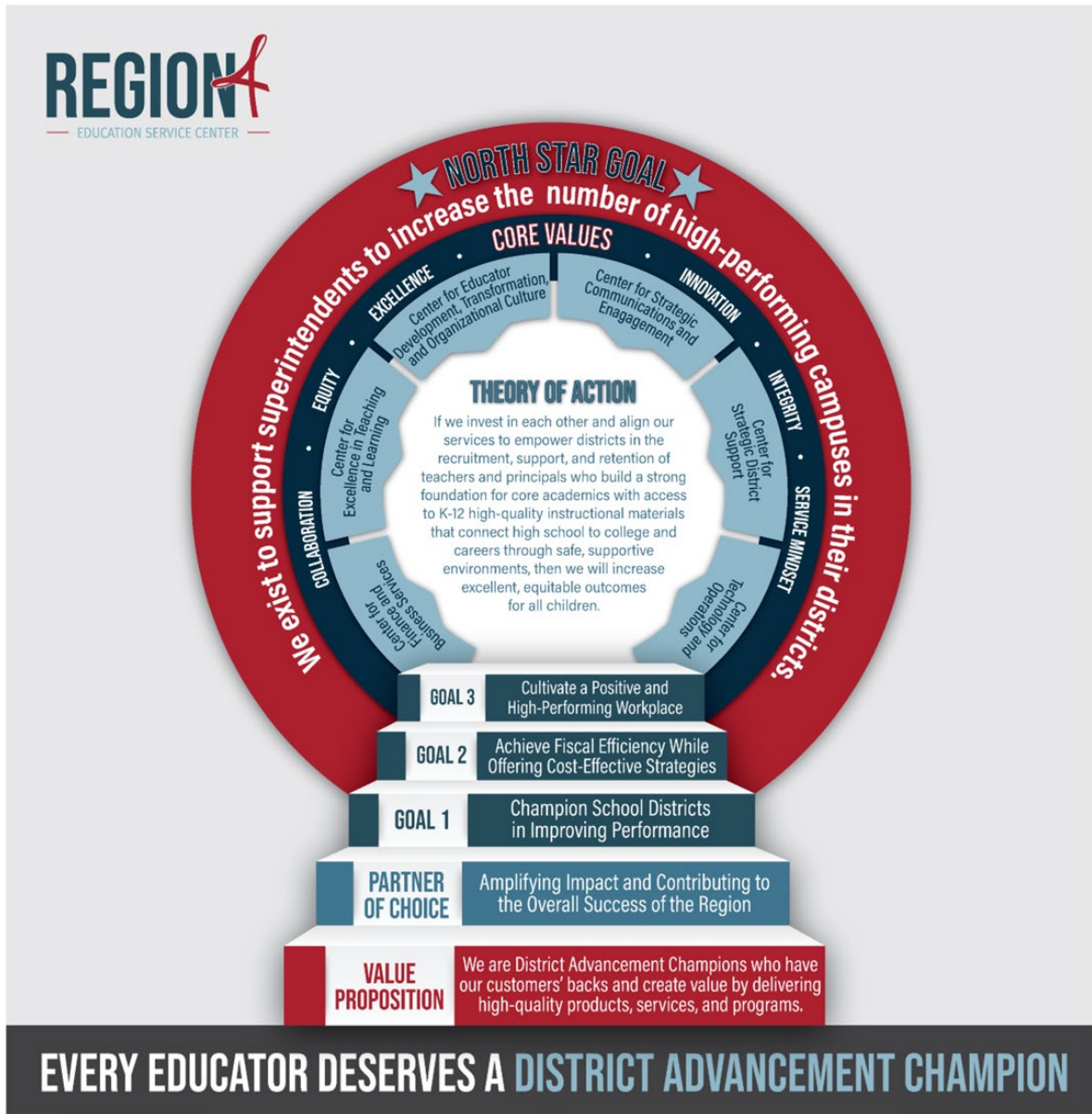

- 3) Satisfaction with other services (Items 10-14)

Superintendent Power Hour Instructions:

The "Superintendent Power Hour" is a session designed to provide superintendents with a collaborative environment to discuss and solve pressing issues. This informal yet structured time allows for open dialogue, shared experiences, and collective problem-solving.

10:35 AM – 10:40 AM | Introduction to Power Hour Focus

- Brief welcome by the session facilitator.
- Explanation of the session's purpose and structure.

10:40 AM - 10:45 AM | Issue Identification

- Participants write down pressing issues or challenges they are facing on sticky notes.
- Sticky notes are placed on a designated "Problem Wall."

10:45 AM – 11:00 AM | Group Formation

- Sticky notes are grouped by common themes or issues by the facilitator.
- Participants choose which group they want to join based on the issue they are most interested in or affected by.

11:00 AM – 11:20 AM | Roundtable Discussions

- Each group moves to a designated area or table.
- Groups engage in focused discussions on their chosen issue.
- Utilize a structured format:
 - Define the problem.
 - Share experiences and previous attempts to solve it.
 - Brainstorm potential solutions.
 - Identify actionable steps.

11:20 AM - 11:35 AM | Share and Summarize

- Each group appoints a spokesperson to briefly share their key insights and proposed solutions with the larger group.
- Facilitator summarizes the common themes and potential action items.

11:35 AM | Transition to Official Meeting

- Thank participants for their engagement.
- Encourage continued discussions during lunch.
